



Variable Fuel Surcharge

New for 2019, all concrete will be charged a Variable Fuel Surcharge. This surcharge is based on the average quarterly rack, and will be adjusted the 1st day of every quarter, based on the previous quarter's average rack rate. The surcharge will be adjusted as outlined in the table below.

Rack Rate	Fuel Surcharge
<\$0.67/L	\$0.00/m ³
\$0.67/L to <\$0.77/L	\$1.00/m ³
\$0.77/L to \$0.97/L (Base)	\$2.00/m ³
\$0.97/L to \$1.07/L	\$3.00/m ³
>\$1.07/L	\$4.00/m ³

The base fuel surcharge is \$2.00/m³, established at average diesel fuel rack rate of \$0.87/L, based on the average rack rate of Q3 2018.

Quarter	Average Rack Rate
2018-Q1	83.2
2018-Q2	88.1
2018-Q3	87.5
2018-Q4	81.8
2019-Q1	73.4
2019-Q2	74.8

The quarterly average rack rate is calculated based on the Monthly Average Wholesale (Rack) Prices for diesel in Toronto, as posted on the Ministry of Natural Resources website.
